Community Policing

Flood Rescue Operation

On 30th September 2021, severe flood affected the entire area of Udaynarayanpur and some parts of Joypur of Howrah (Rural) District where area were sub-merged with water, 86 village of Udaynarayanpur and 25 villages of Joypur PS were affected. Approx-2,30,796 people were affected.



Eye check up camp at Panchla PS
